#### Support families served by RWC with a Baby Bottle Fundraiser!

The fundraiser is easy and doesn't require a lot of hands on work. You can pick up or we can deliver the baby bottles to your church or organization. Over the course of 3-4 weeks, your members take a bottle home, fill it with cash or checks, and return the bottle on the designated collection date. A member of our staff can pick up the filled baby bottles or you can drop them off to us at the end of the fundraiser. It's that simple!

#### **Four Easy Steps**

#### 1. Decide how many baby bottles your church or organization needs

For a church/organization of 100-200 people, 50-75 bottles will work. If you have a smaller or larger organization, you can request bottles accordingly. We only ask that you please encourage your members to return all baby bottles, both full and empty. Because this fundraiser runs all year for us and various organizations participate, we reuse all of our bottles. When bottles are not returned, we have to purchase new bottles. Help us be good stewards.

#### 2. Choose the campaign dates

There are so many dates to choose from throughout the year! There are no set times; 3-4 weeks is standard for the fundraiser. For churches we ask that you begin and end on a Sunday. For example, you can schedule it as a "back to school" fundraiser through the month of August, a "Valentine' gift of love" campaign through the month of February, a "Mother's day celebration" for May, or a "Father's Day celebration" for June, etc. Having a theme allows your members to associate the holiday with the donation time. If you need help deciding on dates, give us a call and we will be more than happy to help!

#### 3. Schedule a time to get the bottles

You can either email – office@rockvillewomenscenter.com or give us a call at (301)-770-4444 with your organization's contact information, number of bottles, and a start and end date. We can arrange for an RWC representative to be present at the start of your fundraiser and/or provide a short video for sharing with your members.

#### 4. Advertise and Announce

In order to make your members aware of the fundraiser, we encourage you to make weekly announcements leading up to the start date. On the week before it's time to return the bottles, make an announcement to **remind everyone to bring all the bottles back, full or empty, by the end of the campaign.**

# ANGIE'S STORY

Hello, my name is Angie and I am sharing our story with you.

It all started on Labor Day weekend of 2021 when I took a home pregnancy test. It seemed positive but I wasn't sure. I was really scared and didn't know what to do. I remember on that Tuesday, after the long weekend, I googled places to take a laboratory pregnancy test and I found The Rockville Women's Center. I called, but hung up immediately. Then I received a call back from the center. Latoya asked me the reason why I had called. I remember telling her that I suspected I was pregnant but didn't know "what to do"! She encouraged me to stop by the center. Even though I was making so many excuses, she shared that the staff would wait for me until I was out of work.

When I came to the center I was really scared because my husband and I weren't in a good situation at the time and I was going through health issues. All my family lives in Colombia; I felt alone, insecure and didn't know what to do.

The pregnancy test was positive. I was sweating and shaking, but I accepted the offer to see the baby. I remember when I saw her on the sonogram, my baby was bouncing ... with a strong heartbeat ... I couldn't stop crying...

The staff gave me tons of information, but strongly encouraged me to pray.

I went back to the center for a second appointment. My baby was growing and moving. When offered a rock, I picked the rock that said 'brave' (I still have it). Even though I was crying and still scared, I decided to be brave! for me and my baby. I decided to become healthy for her. It was in that moment when God showed me that I wasn't alone!!! At the center I found a family, a support, a rock...

My relationship with my husband miraculously started to change. He began to care, to be present for us: God showed me that I wasn't alone anymore and that 'I COULD DO EVERYTHING THROUGH HIM WHO STRENGTHENS ME.'

So since that day I found that praying has a lot of power and that everything does happen for a good reason... I called the center because God had great plans for me. I have become someone who trusts in God's plans ... but I wouldn't have done it without the love, support and prayers I found here at the center.



### LYLES' STORY

#### JANUARY 2020

I found out I was pregnant at 19 weeks. I thought the world was going to end. I have never and hopefully I will never cry as much as I did that day. I was afraid of so many things – disappointing my mom and elder sister, what the church would say, things going wrong and I have to end up raising a child by myself. I was afraid I wouldn't live up to my highest potential as far as my dreams were concerned.

I scheduled an abortion at three different places. I went to the first one but I was too far gone for that facility and was given a list of places that could do it for me. When I got home, I was looking for possible cheaper places when I came across RWC.

I scheduled an appointment. I was told RWC doesn't do abortions but they provide information and talk to you. I accepted. On the day of my appointment, I was so down I almost didn't show up, but something pushed me to drive one hour from Baltimore to Rockville. To make the long story short, the staff at RWC helped me realize that **all the reasons I had for wanting an abortion had nothing to do with me.** It was about everyone else.

During the ultrasound, my eyes were open – I saw the baby kicking and heard the heart beating. I started to question my decision that I thought no one could make me change. I couldn't have an abortion.

I just saw this child looking so peaceful. I changed my mind instantly. The staff showed me some rocks, I picked the one that read "Hope" – I was hoping I had made the right decision; hoping everything would turn out for the best. I did not show up to any of the two surgical abortions.

I spent the next 4 months wondering how life would turn out. I cried almost every day. I quit jobs for no reason. I stopped taking classes at RWC and going to church. I couldn't even pray at home.

On November 27, 2019, I found out I was having a baby girl – that was the proudest moment of my pregnancy. All the fear literally disappeared. I felt the weight lift off my shoulders. I stopped dressing to hide my stomach and even posted pictures online.

Fast forward to January 9, 2020, my baby girl was born – 7lbs 8oz; absolutely no complication with mom or baby. Family and friends drove from far and near to see us.

I was wondering who would care for my baby while I worked. Then a family friend came to see us and she was accompanied by her sister, a retired pediatrician. The pediatrician offered to care for my baby at a very affordable price. **God literally brought a babysitter into my house.** Everything I was ever afraid of, God went ahead of me and perfected for me.

Dear staff at Rockville Women Center, thank you for helping me rise above fear and not making what would have been the greatest mistake of my life. I thought having a child without being married would be the end of the world, but its evident life really just began.

I named my daughter Genesis because she's the beginning of my new life. She's the beginning of all things great. I am going to make sure I become everything I've ever wanted to become so she's not assumed to be the reason I didn't accomplish certain goals. Thank you all again for all you do. Thank You.



#### MAY 2023

Hello RWC family. Hope you all are doing well. Below is an update on Genesis and me. Thank you all for all you do.

The first year of Genesis being here was a little rough for her dad and me. I finally left him when my daughter was only two months old (so much for someone who was terrified about being a single mom). I thought the world was going to end but God's grace has been more than sufficient. We had to sit down and talk about halfway through that year. The sit down enabled us to let go of all the pain and unforgiveness. With that forgiveness came a lot of peace. We've been co-parenting really well ever since.


I felt the need to add this as part of the update because that was one of my biggest worries while pregnant. He moved to New Jersey about two years ago but comes to see her periodically, and sends financial support for her. He also calls on FaceTime at least weekly to talk to her. Now that she's older, if he hasn't called, she asks me to call. He doesn't give me any hard time, and I don't trouble him either. His twin brother also calls from back home to check on Genesis and me.

Genesis and I are trusting God to help us get a house next year. To show God how serious we are, I am deliberate in getting out of debt and have paid off my credit cards which totaled nearly \$10,000. I'm taking classes at the University of Maryland Global Campus to have better and stable income.

By the grace of God, Genesis is extremely smart. She knows her numbers and colors. She also knows everyone in my immediate family by their names. She even knows most of my friends and the names of their children. She can ride her tricycle, read her father's name in my phone contacts, and knows my real name although she calls me *mommy*. You dare not push the elevator button – that's her job. She puts on and takes off her shoes correctly by herself. She also does not allow anyone to buckle her seatbelt for her as she often says "Nooooo I'll do it." We might end up going late to the doctor's appointment waiting ten minutes for her to do it but she does it – eventually. She also randomly tells me "mommy let's pray" and requests "mommy let's go to church." She loves singing gospel songs and thinks she can play a piano – I go along with the thinking.

Genesis joined me in the ushering department a couple of months ago; making her the youngest usher in my church. I greet congregants as they walk through the first door, she opens the second door for them to walk into the church. Thanks again for all you do.
