



## Donors' Impact on Our Community

### Overview

January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023

- 164 abortion-minded women seen for the first time
- 71 women returned for a second appointment
- 100 women sought to confirm pregnancy
- 117 families received material resources
- 51 moms brought in their newborn baby for a visit
- 18 parents participated in the mentoring program
- 4 parents participated in childbirth and breastfeeding classes
- 1 woman participated in post-abortion counseling

## Mission

To empower abortion-vulnerable women to embrace life-affirming decisions.



## Vision

To be the first stop for abortion-vulnerable women and a formidable presence for advancing God's plan for a life-affirming culture throughout the Washington Metropolitan Region.



Gina, a high school student came to the center in June 2023 for an initial appointment; she left intending to terminate her pregnancy. She did not come back for a follow-up and she didn't respond to our attempts to contact her. So, we prayed. God is a Way Maker. In December 2023, Gina and her mom came to the center as a walk-in appointment. Gina's mom had just found out that Gina was pregnant, and the only place Gina trusted was RWC. We were excited to see Gina.

The ultrasound revealed a healthy baby even though Gina had not received prenatal care. Gina told our advocate that she couldn't go through with terminating her pregnancy and didn't know what would have happened if her mom had not found out about her pregnancy. She was interested in having a mentor and we had a mentor who was ready to serve. **Praise be to**

**God on January 4, 2024, baby Valentina was born – pictured on the left with Lena (mentor).**

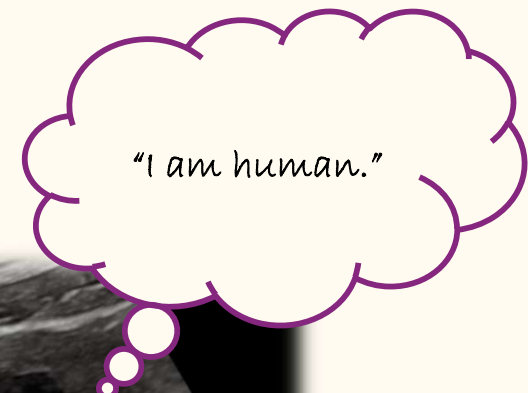

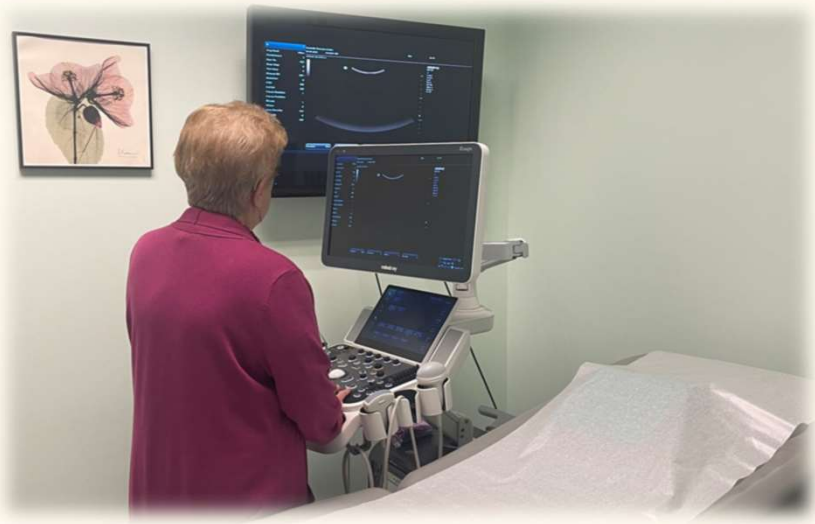
